## Committee Updates

#### New Committee member



The committee is delighted to welcome a new member to our ranks. Pat McCarthy was confirmed as a committee member during our February 2024 meeting.

### Canopy maintenance

Many people will be aware our KBC building canopy was damaged by a vehicle on Karori Road. This has created quite a bit of work for the committee because the damage exposed the poor condition of the canopy structure. So far we have:

- Requested & received a payout from the insurance company
- Engaged an Engineer who has advised considerable work is required to upgrade the canopy
- Installed a temporary pole to support the structure, as recommended by the engineer
- Obtained a builder's quote to fix the canopy (this was prohibitively high)
- Obtained a quote to demolish the canopy rather than replace it (WCC has confirmed we have permission to do this)

#### Strategic Plan

### **Cashless payments**

We are in the process of introducing cashless payments for table money. This will make life easier for members, the Club Manager and directors. Cashless payments are made to the Club much the same as with coupons. Each time you play the scorer software will take the table money and keep track of how much money you have left. Statements with your balance will be sent to you via email twice a month for you to review. Should your balance be in arrears you will be given a reminder to top it up.
